ORDER

S. R. O. No. 111/64.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Kerala Stamp Act, 1953 (Act 17 of 1953), and in supersession of Madras Government Notification No. 13 dated 17th December, 1938, as subsequently amended so far as it relates to items 86 specified therein, the Government of Kerala, being of opinion that it is necessary in the public interest so to do, hereby reduce the duties with which all instruments of gifts or settlements for charitable or religious purposes are chargeable under the said Act, to one half of the said duties.
